Chief Financial Officer

Short Description

The Chief Financial Officer is a key contributor on the executive team who serves to drive the strategic direction for and oversee the Finance, Accounting, and Risk Management teams. Manages the financial accounting functions of the credit union, including ALM, budgets, general ledger, financial analysis, financial reporting, investments, and forecasting activities. Works effectively with regulators, governance committees, leaders, and partners to ensure compliance with all regulations. Leverages tools, data, and market conditions to deliver relevant business insights and recommendations for operational efficiency.

Full Description

The CFO will participate in the credit union's long and short-term strategic planning. Oversee budget planning, preparation, and administration processes to control operating expenses and achieve the credit union's strategic direction.

Communicate with the Board of Directors, the Supervisory Committee, and the Management Team regarding strategic recommendations, financial results, and policies that affect the credit union to ensure that they are informed about matters which affect the financial institution.

Develop, implement, and evaluate policies and procedures for the Accounting/Finance Department. Ensure that policies and procedures reflect current regulations and are communicated to and implemented by subordinates.

Represent the credit union at external functions, attend board meetings, and report on assigned areas requested by the President/CEO.

Hold periodic staff meetings. Identify areas for improvement, procedures, new developments, or changes in services. Keep staff up to date on trends and general credit union information.

Assist with vendor negotiation and major purchasing decisions.

Develop, perform, and oversee various internal audit procedures, i.e. cash counts, teller drawer audits, review of employee accounts, loan documentation, wire transfers, etc.

Serve as the credit union's liaison with regulatory agency examiners and auditors.
