Young Professionals Group Description

The LSCU Young Professionals Group (YPG) is made up of credit union professionals, 40 years of age and younger, in Alabama, Florida and Georgia working to positively impact the credit union movement. The goals of this program are improved industry awareness, increased knowledge and professional development, and a collaborative spirit among young credit union professionals.

Board Descriptions

President



Overall, the President is responsible for providing leadership for the YPG. It is the duty of the president to give the group direction and motivate others to support the YPG. The president strives to keep all activities working towards the good of the group, chapter, the League, credit unions, and credit union members.

Vice President

The vice president lends vital assistance to the president and may be assigned specific duties, such as chairing special projects or programming, and may be called upon to assist as necessary for the good of the group. In the president's absence, the vice president will be called upon to fulfill the role and should be thoroughly familiar with all duties.

Secretary

The secretary shall keep a record of the meetings of the group and YPG officials. The accuracy and completeness of the group's records are the responsibility of the secretary.

Treasurer

The treasurer shall be responsible for accounting for funds and property in possession of the group.

Director

While the YPG Director is not a required position, a YPG Director may be installed as an additional resource to the YPG's Board. YPG Directors play an important role in ensuring that all interested credit unions are represented and that YPG meeting information is shared appropriately.

Legislative Liaison

Credit unions consistently rank legislative advocacy as the most important service the League can provide. Legislative representation is critical to the continued survival of the credit union movement, and the real political strength is in the grassroots efforts of chapters and credit unions. The vital legislative link between the League and the credit union is the Legislative Liaison.
