

# **February 2021 League Report**

#### **ADVOCACY**

Due to coronavirus concerns, the CUNA Governmental Affairs Conference will take place March 2-4<sup>th</sup> as a virtual event. LSCU looks forward to seeing you and your team at GAC for general sessions and networking breakout sessions. Hill visits with our lawmakers at the federal level are always a highly-anticipated aspect of the conference; however, because LSCU hosts over fifty lawmakers between three states, some visits will take place in the days surrounding the conference. The Alabama legislature gaveled into session on February 2nd. Key priorities include COVID-19 liability protection, economic development incentives, and ensuring the Alabama tax code aligns with the federal tax relief provisions of the CARES ACT. LSCU's main priorities this session will be to pass legislation clarifying the Financial Institution Excise Tax as it pertains to credit unions, as well as ensuring credit unions have measures to protect elderly members from account exploitation.

The Georgia General Assembly convened on Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup>. The legislature will be focused on continued impacts of COVID-19, election reform, and restoring budget cuts seen in 2020. Other legislative activity has been slow to move, as the leaders of the General Assembly are very cautious of rising COVID-19 cases in Georgia. LSCU is part of a large coalition pursuing Remote Online Notarization, advancing the annual Department of Banking and Finance Housekeeping Bill, and protecting the credit union tax exemption.

The Florida Legislature begins on Tuesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Legislature will focus on COVID civil liability and balancing Florida's budget amid an economic downturn. While the League has many priorities for credit unions this year, we are focused on COVID civil liability, updating the process for remote online notarizations, and defeating a proposed expansion to PACE loans.
